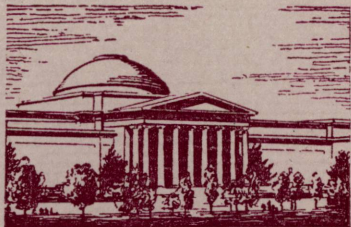

SPECIAL EXHIBITION: November 23 to December 14. Ground Floor Gallery. *Men of Action of the Naval Services, World War II*, portrait paintings and drawings by official Navy Combat artists, executed in the principal theatres of operation during and since hostilities.
