The noble portraits of Nanteuil in the 17th century contrast with the vividness of Callot and the tranquility of Claude. The grace and delicacy of French 18th century prints in color and black have, in their field, never been approached. Among the moderns we have the sharply contrasting geniuses of Ingres and Delacroix, Daumier and Corot, Cézanne and Degas, Lautrec and Picasso.
