Paintings and sculpture comprising the Mellon, Samuel H. Kress, Widener and Chester Dale Collections, with gifts from other donors, are located on the main floor. The Widener Collection of decorative arts is on the ground floor.

A new motion picture of the National Gallery of Art, *Art in the Western World*, will be shown each Sunday at 4 p.m. This film is available on loan for educational purposes (16 mm., color). Running time 30 minutes.

A slide lecture, prepared by Noel Smith, Gallery Horticulturist, covers the Gallery's landscaping and the culture and arrangement of the plants used in the building. This lecture will be given in the Gallery auditorium to garden clubs and other groups by arrangement with the Building Superintendent's office.

A radio lecture device, running continuously, is installed in eighteen exhibition galleries. The talks cover most of the periods of art represented in the collections. For 25c a visitor may rent a small receiving set to use in hearing these LecTour broadcasts.
