Three lectures on Byzantine Art and its influence will be given in December.

The American Vision will be shown in auditorium at 2:15 p.m. on December 3, 17, 24 and 31. The film has won several cent awards, including a top honor at the Chicago International Film Festival in November.

On Christmas and New Year's Day the Gallery will be closed; no concerts will be given.
