THE LEAGUE OF COMPOSERS presented its first concert in the City of New York on November 11, 1923. Its first circular stated that "The organization intended to encourage and give support to the production of new and significant works. It will effect cooperation between composers of all nations and give well planned performances of new music selected from every school. While first performances will be a feature of the League's concerts, they will not exclude such modern works as may have been given before, and which are of sufficient importance to be given a rehearing."
