PROGRAM

Concert pianist RITA BOUBOULIDI set a precedent in 1980 by performing the monumental cycle of all thirty-two Beethoven piano sonatas in seven consecutive recitals in New York City, a feat which she repeated in Washington at Dumbarton Oaks in 1983 and again in New York in 1985. A musician of broad affinities, she has also given performances in Boston and New York of the rarely played Schoenberg *Concerto* and presented the New York premiere of a piano concerto by Ned Rorem at Carnegie Hall.

An international virtuoso, Rita Bouboulidi has toured extensively and played as soloist with the Boston, Pittsburgh, Baltimore and American Symphony Orchestras, as well as with the London Philharmonia, the Munich Philharmonic and the Paris *Société des Concerts du Conservatoire*. She has participated in the festivals of Athens, Bratislava, Brussels ("Europalia"), Salzburg and Scheveningen, and has performed on live television broadcasts in Spain, France, Greece, Mexico and Chicago, as well as New York's WQXR and WNCN Radio Stations. She has recorded for *Erato* Records and *Disques Charlin*, and is currently in the process of recording the complete Beethoven sonatas for the Greek National Radio in Athens.
