Abstract	This collection consists of lectures, essays, correspondence, and other material related to Erwin O. Christensen's professional activities in the areas of folk art and museum development.

Biographical Note

Erwin O. Christensen was born in St. Louis, MO in 1890. He received bachelor's and master's degrees in architecture from the University of Illinois and Harvard University, respectively. In 1946, he became the curator of the Index of American Design at the National Gallery of Art and served until his retirement in 1960. He taught art history at several higher education institutions, including Syracuse University, before joining the National Gallery. He published several titles during his career including the first comprehensive publication on the Index of American Design in 1950.

Scope and Content

This collection is arranged in three groups: lectures and essays; material related to a US State Department-sponsored lecture tour to Pakistan; and correspondence. The lectures and essays make up the bulk of the records. The Pakistan files consist of correspondence, news clippings, receipts, travel vouchers, and other items. The correspondence files relate to Christensen's professional activities.

Arrangement

The lectures and essays are arranged in chronological order. The Pakistan material is arranged by subject. The correspondence is arranged in alphabetical order, by major correspondent or subject.
