Biographical Note

Hereward Lester Cooke was born in Princeton, NJ in 1916. He received a bachelor's degree from Oxford University in 1937. He went on to earn both a Master of Fine Arts and doctorate from Princeton University in 1949 and 1956, respectively. Cooke began his career at the National Gallery of Art as an aide in 1955 and would eventually serve as the Curator of Painting from 1961 to 1973. From 1963 to 1973, he was an art advisor for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA). He died on October 5, 1973.

Scope and Content

This collection mostly consists of material created and compiled by art curator H. Lester Cooke, documenting his biography, professional and research activities, and his participation in the NASA Art Program. Contents include correspondence, handwritten drafts and research notes, photographs, biographical sketches, exhibition brochures, writings, and articles.
